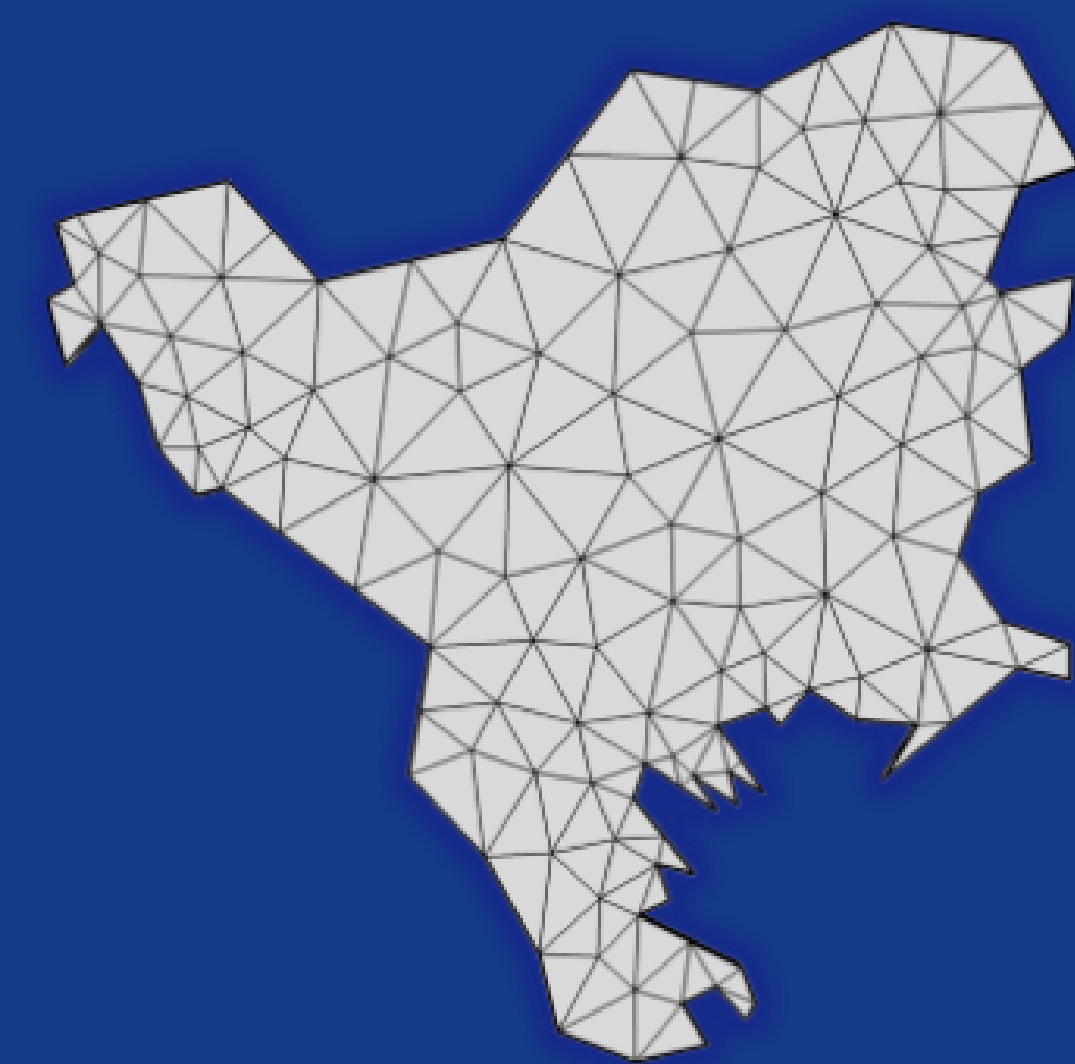


# BalkanCom 2019
