Guidelines for formatting final, camera-ready papers

We highly recommend using Microsoft Word or LaTeX to prepare your document. To ensure proper formatting, we suggest using the IEEE templates. If you choose not to use these templates, please note that you may encounter issues during the camera-ready submission stage.

The maximum number of pages for the document is six pages.

Your manuscript should not include any headers, footers, or page numbers. Please adhere to the margins specified in the table below, as papers with margins smaller than those provided will not be accepted:

It is necessary to use either Post Script or True Type fonts that are licensed for embedding. The use of unlicensed, custom-made, or manipulated fonts is strictly prohibited, and your submission will be rejected if such fonts are discovered. We have provided a list of recommended fonts below:

For graphics and images, it is recommended to choose vector graphics (such as .eps or .pdf) over bitmap images (such as .bmp, .png, or .jpg) because they are more efficient and do not pose issues when converted to PDF.

The resolution of images should be between 150 and 300 dpi or less. Resolutions exceeding 300 will result in downsampling, while images below 300 will not render well in print.

Labels within graphics should have a type point size of 4 or higher.
